What does the training involve?

You will get to know the user interfaces of your GEUTEBRÜCK system in detail. Learn how to operate the G-View (G-Core) and OpCon (G-SIM) software so that you can get the maximum benefit from it. You will switch on cameras, work with alarms, export image data or compile all relevant images for a search.

In the online phase, we introduce you to the company and basic knowledge about video technology. You will also learn the basics of the software. You will need this knowledge in the presence phase. In the classroom phase, you will then learn the individual steps in the user interface. You will work with the system in the same way as you use it in your everyday work.

Who is the training aimed at?

Users of GEUTEBRÜCK systems who have to deal with the operation of the systems (G-Core & G-SIM) on a daily basis. Both user interfaces will be trained on one day. If you only use G-Core, please let us know in advance.



When does the online period take place?
