What does the training involve?

In the presence phase you will then use a practical example to put a recorder with the G-Core software into operation.

When does the online period take place?

The online phase takes place in the period after your registration and necessarily before the classroom event. As soon as you have registered for a training you will get access to the Geutebrück Online Academy and find your preparatory training modules there. These are a mandatory part of the overall training and must be completed by the beginning of the classroom training. Otherwise, no certificate can be handed out at the end of the training. When and how you work through the modules is up to you. In this way, you can acquire the necessary basic knowledge independent of time and place and integrate the further training into your everyday work in the best possible way.

Why do the online courses have to be completed in the preliminary stages?



Anyone who has ever taken part in a training course or a training course knows the following situation. The group has different levels of previous knowledge and during the training the gap between the participants becomes larger rather than smaller.
